AICTE SPONSORED FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM AT COP-BELA

A two weeks AICTE sponsored Faculty Development Program was organized by ASBASJSM College of Pharmacy, Bela on “Enhancing Moral, Ethical and Emotional Competencies in Pharmacy Students: The Need for Paradigm Shift in Pedagogy” from 5th October to 19th October 2019. FDP was focused on rationale and arguments for the presence of morals, values, ethics and character education in technical curriculum and teaching. Various obstacles in teaching morals or ethics and implementing character education in the technical course were discussed. A range of teaching, learning and pedagogical techniques were also scheduled in FDP to foster morals, values and ethics in students’ mind and develop various skills and attributes necessary for success in their technical era. The FDP was attended by 40 participants that included 33 external participants (from all over India) and 07 internal participants (from ASBASJSM college of Pharmacy, Bela). 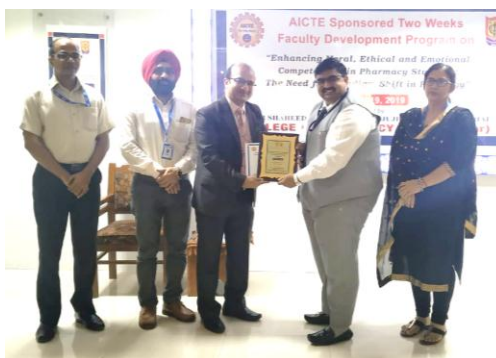
