## Agenda No. 2 Quality of Teaching and Learning

IQAC emphasized improving the quality of teaching and learning in pharmacy education is crucial for preparing competent and compassionate pharmacists who can meet the evolving needs of patients and healthcare systems. This involves a multi-faceted approach focusing on curriculum, pedagogy, faculty development, student support, and continuous assessment. The IQAC set a standard of 60% marks in internal assessments and 50% marks in the end term examination for a minimum of 80% of students is found satisfactory in all courses.

Course file pattern for Theory & Practical were also approved.

# Agenda No. 3 Quality of Improvement in competitive examination and placements.

IQAC has proactively encouraged the students for GPAT, Drug Inspector, Pharmacist recruitment exams. Thoroughly familiarize students with the specific exam format, types of questions, and syllabus. This includes understanding the weightage of different sections. Encourage students to create detailed and structured study schedules that cover all topics. Emphasize the use of quality study materials, including recommended textbooks. reference guides, previous years' question papers, and reliable online resources. Strengthen understanding of core pharmacy subjects like Pharmaceutics, Pharmacology, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, and Pharmacognosy. This forms the bedrock for both academic and professional success.

IQAC has proactively encouraged the Training and Placement Cell to broaden its outreach efforts for the effective training and placement of students. This involving expanding collaboration with pharmaceutical companies: Establish and maintain robust relationships with pharmaceutical companies, hospitals, research institutions, and other relevant organizations. This facilitates internship opportunities, industrial visits, guest lectures by industry experts, and direct placement assistance.

#### Agenda No. 4 Skill development of students

IQAC recommended the initiation of Comprehensive Placement Preparation Programs:

Skill Enhancement Workshops: Conduct regular training sessions and workshops focusing on essential employability skills:

- Resume writing and cover letter creation.
- Interview techniques (including mock interviews),
- Group discussion skills.

- Communication and interpersonal skills.
- Overall personality development.
- Soft skills and professional etiquette.

Career Guidance and Counselling: Provide individualized career counselling to help students explore diverse career paths within the pharmaceutical industry (pharmacist, drug inspector, pharmacologist, clinical researcher, quality control, medical writing, etc.) and make informed decisions.

Some Industrial Visit, Hospital, Institutional, Medicinal Garden Visit to be organized in coming session.
